





- Gospel, power of God, to be preached to all Mk. 16:15; Rom. 1:16
- Must preach the cross of Christ









What it means to Preach the Cross

A substitutionary death. I Pet. 2:24
"Bare"—Bear sacrifice up on the altar
His body became the sacrificial victim, the cross the altar on which it was offered

- The awfulness of sin. Cf. Eph. 2:11
- Glory in a shameful thing. Heb. 12:2; I Cor. 1:31; Gal. 6:14

Effective Preaching of the Cross

- Not with wisdom of words. I Cor. 1:17; 2:4
- Declares facts of the gospel. I Cor. 15:1-4
- Declares promises. 2 Pet. 1:4; I Jn. 2:25
- Declares commands. Mk. 16:15-16; Acts 2:38

Effective Preaching of the Cross

Shows how receive benefits.

Gospel obedience. Acts 18:8; Rom. 6:3-4, etc. Lord Supper, proclamation and remembrance. I Cor. 11:23-26

- Godly living. I Cor. 15:58

Conclusion

- The story of the cross can lead sinners to salvation in Christ.
- When saved by the gospel, one an glory in no personal accomplishment—only in the Lord. I Cor. 1:31
