Flee The Abomination Of Desolations
<b>Lk. 21:20</b> "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then recognize that her desolation is at hand."
Matt. 24:15-22 "Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand)"
Desolation Explained: Jeremiah (4:27; 6:8; etc.) & Ezekiel
Desolation Prophesied: Daniel 9:2,18,26; 11:31; 12:11

The Abomination Of Desolations

1M slain, 97,000 captives — arena, tortured, or sold as slaves.

Josephus: "It appears to me that the misfortune of all men from the beginning of the world, if they were compared to those of the Jews, are not so considerable as this" (Preface to Wars, Sec. 4).

When the Romans entered the temple, Titus rushed into the holy place, viewing the indescribable beauty of the building and its contents, cried out to his soldiers to put out the fire and save the building. But it was too late.
